PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF FINAL DETERMINATION OF PENNSYLVANIA OFFICE OF OPEN RECORDS

AND NOW, come the Appellant, Municipality of Monroeville, by and through its counsel, Robert J. Wratcher, Esquire, and files the Petition For Judicial Review of Final Determination of the Pennsylvania Office of Open Records, and in support thereof states the following:

I. NATURE OF THE ACTION

1. Appellant, Municipality of Monroeville, is a political subdivision organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the "Municipality"), with a principal office at 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania 15146.

2. Appellee, John Yakim ("Yakim"), is an individual who resides at 1033 Harvard Road, Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania 15146.

3. On August 1, 2016, Yakim filed a Right To Know Request ("RTKL Request") with the Municipality, which requested the following:

"I am requesting correspondence to or from Members of Council, Mayor Erosenko, Manager Little, Sharon McIndoe and members of the Home Rule Charter Committee which discuss the Home Rule Charter or the work of the HRC Committee. This should include, but not be limited to any emails,

notes, agendas, discussions of meetings or discussions of agendas. This should include any emails received or sent from personal email accounts or cell phones which discuss this official business. Please have ALL members of council, Manager Little, Mayor Erosenko and members of the committee attest to the completeness of the request. Date range July 1 - June 30, 2016.”

A copy of Yakim’s RTKL Request is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. On August 8, 2016, Joseph Sedlak, the Open Records representative for the Municipality (“Sedlak”) the Municipality requested a thirty (30) day extension on review of the RTKL Request to complete a legal review. A copy of Sedlak’s letter is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

5. On September 7, 2016, Sedlak granted the RTKL Request in part by providing redacted documents to Yakim and denied the RTKL Request in part, stating that:

a.) the documents were redacted pursuant to Section 708 (b)(6)(i) of the Pennsylvania Right To Know Law because they contained personal identification information containing all or part of a person’s social security number, driver’s license number, personal financial information, home, cellular or personal telephone number, personal email address, employee number or other confidential identification number.

A copy of Sedlak’s letter outlining the reasons for providing the redacted documents is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

6. On September 7, 2016, Yakim appealed the denial of the RTKL Request to the Pennsylvania Office of Open Records (“OOR”) at Docket No. AP 2016-1516. A copy of the Notice of Appeal is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

7. By final determination dated October 6, 2016 (the “Final Determination”), OOR granted Yakim’s appeal. The OOR directed the Municipality to provide all responsive records to Yakim within thirty (30) days of the date of Final Determination. A copy of the Final Determination is attached hereto as Exhibit E.

II. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

8. Jurisdiction exists and venue is proper in the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County pursuant to 65 P.S. §67.1302, since the Municipality is located in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and the within appeal has been taken within thirty (30) days of the Final Determination.

III. GROUNDS FOR APPEAL

9. The previous paragraphs are adopted by reference as if set forth at length herein.
10. The Final Determination of OOR is erroneous and contrary to law in that:
- a.) the Municipality's response to the request was inclusive of all of the responsive records known to the Municipality to be in existence;
 - b.) the OOR's conclusion that the Municipality did not provide access to all responsive records is arbitrary and capricious.
 - c.) the Municipality cannot be compelled to produce records that don't exist.

WHEREFORE, Appellant, Municipality of Monroeville respectfully requests that this Honorable Court reverse the Final Determination made by OOR and enter judgment in its favor.






Dear Mr. Yakim:





Dear Parties:

Please review this information carefully as it affects your legal rights.

The Office of Open Records ("OOR") received this appeal under the Right-to-Know Law ("RTKL"), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101, *et seq.* on September 7, 2016. This letter describes the appeal process. A binding Final Determination will be issued pursuant to the timeline required by the RTKL. In most cases, that means within 30 calendar days.

OOR Mediation: This is a voluntary, informal process to help parties reach a mutually agreeable settlement on records disputes before the OOR. To participate in mediation, both parties must agree in writing. If mediation is unsuccessful, both parties will be able to make submissions to the OOR, and the OOR will have 30 calendar days from the conclusion of the mediation process to issue a Final Determination.

Note to Parties: Statements of fact must be supported by an affidavit or attestation made under penalty of perjury by a person with actual knowledge. Any factual statements or allegations submitted without an affidavit will not be considered. The agency has the burden of proving that records are exempt from public access (*see* 65 P.S. § 67.708(a)(1)). To meet this burden, the agency must provide evidence to the OOR. The law requires the agency position to be supported by sufficient facts *and* citation to all relevant sections of the RTKL, case law, and OOR Final Determinations. An affidavit or attestation is required to show that records do not exist. Blank sample affidavits are available on the OOR's website.

Submissions to OOR: Both parties may submit information and legal argument to support their positions by 11:59:59 p.m. seven (7) business days from the date of this letter. *Submissions sent via postal mail and received after 5:00 p.m. will be treated as having been received the next business day.* The agency may assert exemptions on appeal even if it did not assert them when the request was denied (*Levy v. Senate of Pa.*, 65 A.3d 361 (Pa. 2013)).


Agency Must Notify Third Parties: If records affect a legal or security interest of an employee of the agency; contain confidential, proprietary or trademarked records of a person or business entity; or are held by a contractor or vendor, the agency must notify such parties of this appeal immediately and provide proof of that notice to the OOR within seven (7) business days from the date on this letter. Such notice must be made by (1) providing a copy of all documents included with this letter; and (2) advising that interested persons may request to participate in this appeal (*see* 65 P.S. § 67.1101(c)).

Commonwealth Court has held that "the burden [is] on third-party contractors ... to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that the [requested] records are exempt." (*Allegheny County Dep't of Admin. Servs. v. A Second Chance, Inc.*, 13 A.3d 1025, 1042 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2011)). Failure of a third-party contractor to participate in an appeal before the OOR may be construed as a waiver of objections regarding release of the requested records.

Law Enforcement Records of Local Agencies: District Attorneys must appoint Appeals Officers to hear appeals regarding criminal investigative records in the possession of a local law enforcement agency. If access to records was denied in part on that basis, the Requester should consider filing a concurrent appeal with the District Attorney of the relevant county.

If you have any questions about the appeal process, please contact the assigned Appeals Officer (contact information is enclosed) and be sure to provide a copy of any correspondence to all other parties involved in this appeal.

I requested the listed records from the Agency named above. By submitting this form, I am appealing the Agency's denial, partial denial, or deemed denial because the requested records are public records in the possession, custody or control of the Agency; the records do not qualify for any exemptions under § 708 of the RTKL, are not protected by a privilege, and are not exempt under any Federal or State law or regulation; and the request was sufficiently specific.

Additional notes regarding RTK appeal

1. The chairman of the committee did not respond to the inquiry.
2. Several members of Council and the Mayor did not respond to the inquiry.
3. Councilwoman Gaydos released an email that was sent to Mayor, Council and Manager Little. Yet several of those stated that they had no responsive records.
4. Committee member Ritter sent an email to the Chairman, yet there was no response from the chairman.
5. Manager Little indicated that the requester could get the documents from the municipal web site. Yet, the municipal web site does not include any work documents given to the committee at the start of each meeting, including agendas.
6. Monroeville has a history of conducting incomplete searches.

On August 1, 2016, John Yakim (“Requester”), submitted a request (“Request”) to the Municipality of Monroeville (“Municipality”) pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law (“RTKL”), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101 *et seq.*, seeking records related to the Municipality’s Home Rule Charter Committee. On August 8, 2016, the Municipality invoked a thirty-day extension to respond to the Request. *See* 65 P.S. § 67.902. On September 7, 2016, the Municipality partially denied the Request, claiming that it redacted personal identification information, 65 P.S. § 67.708(b)(6), from the requested records.

On September 7, 2016, the Requester filed an appeal with the Office of Open Records (“OOR”), claiming that the Municipality did not conduct a good faith search for the requested records, challenging the redactions, and stating grounds for disclosure. The OOR invited both parties to supplement the record and directed the Municipality to notify any third parties of their ability to participate in this appeal. *See* 65 P.S. § 67.1101(c). The Municipality did not make a submission in this matter.

Section 708 of the RTKL clearly places the burden of proof on the public body to demonstrate that a record is exempt from disclosure. 65 P.S. § 67.708(a). In the present case, the Municipality did not provide any factual or legal support for denying access to responsive records. Based on the Municipality’s failure to provide any evidentiary basis in support of an exemption under the RTKL or the non-existence of responsive records, the Municipality did not meet its burden of proof under the RTKL. *See* 65 P.S. § 67.305; *Hodges v. Pa. Dep’t of Health*, 29 A.3d 1190, 1192 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2011).

For the foregoing reasons, Requester’s appeal is **granted**, and the Municipality is required to provide all responsive records within thirty (30) days. This Final Determination is binding on all parties. Within thirty (30) days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, any party may appeal or petition for review to the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas. 65 P.S. § 67.1302(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall



be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to Section 1303 of the RTKL. However, as the quasi-judicial tribunal adjudicating this matter, the OOR is not a proper party to any appeal and should not be named as a party.¹ This Final Determination shall be placed on the website at: <http://openrecords.pa.gov>.
