ORDER

AND NOW, this 25 day of March, 2014, we hereby deny the application of the Pennsylvania Association of School Retirees (PASR), Ureneus V. Kirkwood, John B. Nye, Stephen M. Vak and Richard Rowland (collectively,

Intervenors) to modify this court's July 28, 2009, injunction as to PASR, and deny the cross-application of Respondents, the Office of Open Records, (OOR), and Terry Mutchler, Executive Director of the OOR, to vacate the injunction.

We clarify this court's July 28, 2009, order granting the requested preliminary injunction as follows:

1. The release of records maintained by public school districts that contain the home addresses of public school employees is hereby stayed until further order of this court.
2. The OOR is enjoined from directing the release of records maintained by public school districts that contain the home addresses of public school employees pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law until further order of this court.
3. The OOR is directed to take all reasonable steps necessary to notify public school districts in the Commonwealth of the existence of this litigation and that the release of records maintained by public school districts that contain the home addresses of public school employees is stayed until further order of this court.
