

OOOR RESPONSE TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

IN RE: *Anonymous v. Pennsylvania State Police*, OOR Dkts. AP 2023-2254 and *Anonymous v. Pennsylvania Department of Transportation*, OOR Dkt. AP 2023-2257

The Office of Open Records (“OOR”) is in receipt of the Requester’s Petitions for Reconsideration (“Petitions”), challenging the dismissal of the above appeals.

I cannot conclude that the Appeals Officer committed any error of law or abuse of discretion that would warrant reconsideration. While the Petitions extensively theorize and debate what can constitute a name, the fact remains that the requests and appeals were made while trying to conceal the Requester’s identity. Indeed, in the Petitions, the Requester makes various averments, including that their identity is somehow all of the following: Walter, Incorporated; Abernathy, J. & McGilterson, R (General Partnership); Breezy Lawns, LLC; Walter John’s Complex Trust; John’s Other Association; Hartford, Connecticut; Estate of Michael Walters; Johnson Family Trust; The Foundation for Learning; John Terrance Abernathy XIV; Big John STEAKS; Eagle Eyes The Third; and, simply, Requester John.

For the foregoing reasons, the Petitions are DENIED.
