Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Appellate Procedure 123, Respondents, Faye Anderson and All That Philly Jazz, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby file this Unopposed Application for Extension of Time to File Brief. In support thereof, Respondents submit as follows:

1. On January 19, 2024, the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (“SEPTA”) filed a Petition for Review of the December 20, 2023 Final Determination of the Pennsylvania Office of Open Records (“OOR”); the petition was docketed at 48 C.D. 2024.
