



FINAL DETERMINATION

DATE ISSUED AND MAILED: April 27, 2026

IN RE: *Auddy Webb v. Allegheny County*, OOR Dkt. AP 2026-1655

Upon review of the appeal filed with the Office of Open Records (“OOR”) to the above-referenced docket number, it is determined that the appeal is **DISMISSED**:

The appeal is premature. The Request was submitted to Allegheny County (“Allegheny County”) on March 17, 2026. The County timely invoked a thirty-day extension of time to respond on March 23, 2026. 65 P.S. § 67.902(b)(1). Under the extension, the County had five (5) business days, followed by thirty (30) calendar days, from March 17, 2026 to respond to the Request. 65 P.S. § 67.902(b)(1)-(2). As a result, the County has until 11:59:59 p.m. on April 23, 2026 to respond to the Request. The appeal was submitted to the OOR on April 23, 2026; thus, the Requester did not allow sufficient time before filing the appeal. The Requester is not prohibited from filing a new appeal to the OOR of any denial or deemed denial stemming from the Request, pursuant to the requirements of 65 P.S. § 67.1101(a)(1).

For this reason, the County is not required to take any further action. Within thirty days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, either party may appeal or petition for review with the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas. 65 P.S. § 67.1302(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to court rules as per 65 P.S. § 67.1303, but as the quasi-judicial tribunal adjudicating this matter, the OOR is not a proper party to any appeal and should not be named as a party.
