



## FINAL DETERMINATION

DATE ISSUED AND MAILED: June 8, 2026

IN RE: *Debbie Behanna v. Monongahela City Police Department*, OOR Dkt. AP 2026-1962

On May 7, 2026, Debbie Behanna (“Requester”) submitted a request (“Request”) to the City of Monongahela Police Department (“Department”) pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law (“RTKL”), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101 *et seq.* The Department did not respond within five business days of receiving the Request, and the Request was, therefore, deemed denied on May 14, 2026. 65 P.S. § 67.901. On May 18, 2026, the Requester filed an appeal with the Office of Open Records (“OOR”).

Local agencies have the burden of proving that records are exempt from access. 65 P.S. § 67.708(a)(1). Here, the Department did not comply with the RTKL by timely responding to the Request, nor did the Department participate on appeal by submitting legal argument or evidence in support of withholding records.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, the Department did not meet its burden of proof under the RTKL. 65 P.S. § 67.305.

For this reason, the appeal is **granted**, the Department is required to provide the requested records to the Requester within thirty days, or, in the alternative, a sworn affidavit or a statement made under the penalty of perjury demonstrating that the records do not exist. Within thirty days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, either party may appeal or petition for review with the Washington County Court of Common Pleas. 65 P.S. § 67.1302(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to court rules as per 65 P.S. § 67.1303, but as the quasi-judicial tribunal adjudicating this matter, the OOR is not a proper party to any appeal and should not be named as a party.<sup>2</sup> All documents or communications following the issuance of this Final Determination shall be sent to [oor-postfd@pa.gov](mailto:oor-postfd@pa.gov).
