



FINAL DETERMINATION

IN RE: *Kailash Kalantri v. Pennsylvania Department of Transportation*; OOR Dkt. AP 2026-3657

Upon review of the appeal filed with the Office of Open Records (“OOR”) to the above-referenced docket number, it is determined that the appeal is **DENIED** because:

The Request does not seek records. The Request was emailed to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (“Department”) on August 25, 2026, asking “[p]lease let me know if the below awards have any Federal Funding or are 100% State funded.” A request under the Right-to-Know Law (“RTKL”) must seek records rather than ask questions. 65 P.S. § 67.102 (defining “Record”); *see also Hodges v. Pa. Dep’t of Corr.*, No. 514 C.D. 2022, 2024 Pa. Commw. Unpub. LEXIS 84, **9-10 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2024) (citing *Walker v. Pa. Ins. Dep’t*, No. 1485 C.D. 2011, 2012 Pa. Commw. Unpub. LEXIS 425 at *16 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2012)) (“The RTKL is not a forum for the public to demand answers to specifically posed questions to either a Commonwealth or local agency. In fact, there is no provision in the RTKL that requires an agency to respond to questions posed in a request”). Although the instant Request does not seek records under the RTKL, nothing in this Final Determination precludes the Requester from filing a new request with the Department seeking specific records and, if necessary, appealing any denial or deemed denial with the OOR pursuant to 65 P.S. § 67.1101(a)(1).

For this reason, the Department is not required to take any further action. Within thirty days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, you may appeal or petition for review in Commonwealth Court. 65 P.S. § 67.1301(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to court rules as per 65 P.S. § 67.1303. However, as the quasi-judicial tribunal adjudicating this matter, the OOR is not a proper party to any appeal and should not be named as a party.¹ All documents or communications following the issuance of this Final Determination shall be sent to oor-postfd@pa.gov.
