



## FINAL DETERMINATION

DATE ISSUED AND MAILED: January 12, 2018

IN RE: *Edward Kennedy v. Schuylkill County Court Administrator*, OOR Dkt. AP 2018-0062

Upon review of the appeal filed with the Office of Open Records (“OOR”) to the above-referenced docket number, it is determined that the appeal is deficient for the reason(s) specified below. Accordingly, the appeal is **DISMISSED**.

- Appeal filed beyond fifteen (15) business days of denial/deemed denial.
- Appeal failed to include a copy of the Request and/or agency Response.
- Appeal failed to state why records are public records and/or address agency grounds for denial of access to records.
- OOR lacks jurisdiction over agency from which records are sought.
- OOR lacks jurisdiction over local agency criminal investigative records.
- Other: Request made to the Schuylkill County Court Administrator. The OOR does not have jurisdiction over judicial records. 65 P.S. § 67.503(b). The Requester may appeal any decision made by the Rule 509 Administrator pursuant to the provisions of Pa. R.J.A. 509.

Within thirty days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, you may appeal or petition for review to the Commonwealth Court. 65 P.S. § 67.1301(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to court rules as per Section 1303. However, as the quasi-judicial tribunal adjudicating this matter, the OOR is not a proper party to any appeal and should not be named as a party.<sup>1</sup> This Final Determination shall be placed on the OOR website at: <http://openrecords.pa.gov>.
